Knitting 101:

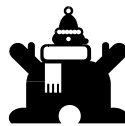
This is a beginning learn-to-knit class. Needle and fiber variations and characteristics are discussed. Techniques for casting on, constructing the knit stitch and if you are ready, the purl stitch are covered. Characteristics of the Garter, Stockinette and Rib

patterns are covered. Casting off is covered at your convenience upon completing your scarf. The instruction is presented by participants knitting a scarf. Fees and Materials: \$15 class fee, yarn and needles (cost varies with personal selection); however, the average cost for this class is approximately \$30 - \$45.



Crochet 101:

This is a beginning learn-to-crochet class. Hook and fiber variations and characteristics are discussed. Techniques for chaining, slip stitch, single and double crochet are covered. The instruction is presented by participants crocheting a scarf. Fees and Materials: \$15 class fee, yarn and hooks (cost varies with personal selection); however, the average cost for this class is approximately \$30-\$45.



Beginning Scarf Technique

Club: This is the best club that you can participate in to advance your beginning skills. You should know how to do the Knit and the Purl Stitch. The rest is up to us to teach you. This club is an excellent way to make holiday gifts all year long. This club will work out of the Little Box of Scarves 1. It will meet monthly from January through December. Each month you'll be required to purchase your supplies from Artistic Fibers and pay a \$10 class fee. If you bring your completed scarf the following month your \$10 fee will be

waved. No exceptions: you must bring your completed project for show and tell to receive your \$10 credit.



Intermediate Scarf Technique

Club I and II: These classes are geared towards students who have taken Beginning Scarf Technique Club in a previous year or for those who have a vast knowledge of knitting. You must know how to knit, purl, increase, decrease, cast on, and bind off. You'll broaden your knowledge of cables, eyelets, color changing, fair isle, interlace, and much more. These Clubs will be working out of the Scarf Style book and must purchase all supplies from Artistic Fibers. Club I will meet bi-monthly (Jan, March, May, July, Sept, Nov), Club II will meet bimonthly (Feb, April, June, Aug, Oct, Dec) and both have a \$10 monthly fee. If you bring your completed project to the next month's class your \$10 fee will be waved. No exceptions: You must bring your completed project to the next month's class for show and tell to receive your \$10 credit.



Advanced Scarf Technique

Club I and II:

This class is geared towards students that have a vast knowledge of knitting skills including cables, specialty increases, specialty decreases, gauge, multiple types of cast on, and bind off. This club will meet bimonthly for **Session I: Jan, March, May, July, Sept, and Nov** and **Session II: Feb, April,**

June, August, Oct, and Dec. You can participate in one or both I and II. Your schedule will determine your level of commitment...monthly or bimonthly. There will be a \$10 monthly fee that can be waved if you bring your completed project the following session for show and tell. No exceptions: you must bring your completed project to the next session.



One Skein Club:

This club is meant to be fun, fun, fun. We will be working out of the brand new book 101 DESIGNER One-Skein Wonders. You must purchase all supplies at Artistic Fibers. There will be a \$10 fee each month for this club. If you bring your finished project for show and tell the following month you will not have to pay your \$10 fee that month. No exception, you must bring your finished project the following month to be waved of the fee.



Elsie Mittens (Embellished

Version): This class will work out of the book Knitting Little Luxuries by Louisa Harding. The model is made using 2 balls of Kimono Angora, one skein of Kimono Ribbon, 6 buttons, and size 3, 6, and 8 straight needles. The fee for this 2 hour class is \$15.

Manos Kid Sweater: This is a PERFECT first time sweater. If you've been longing to make a sweater this

would be the class to take. In the Jan session you'll be selecting yarn, needles, and the type of sweater you'll be making. We will be working out of the spiral pattern book Manos Kids #1. You'll do a gauge swatch, map out the pattern for your size, cast on, and start knitting your sleeves. There is a series of increases in the sleeves that we'll go over. You'll need to complete all your sweater pieces by the end of February for session 2: seaming. The sweater can be made in size 1-8 years. If you don't know a kid to give your sweater to and still want to learn how to make a sweater we will help you find a great place to donate it, or put it out for sale. The 1st session has a fee of \$30 and the 2nd session in Feb. is \$20. All supplies must be purchased at Artistic Fibers.

Schaefer Pig: You have to stop in to see this "too cute" pig. Every little one in your life will want one. It is constructed out of LOLA from Schaefer. Lola is a worsted weight, washable, yarn that comes in bright, variegated colors. This class fee is \$15 and all supplies must be purchased at Artistic Fibers. Your pattern is FREE with the purchase of your yarn.

Stamper's 6 Club: This is a group of 6 of us that meet to stamp with our favorite Stampin' Up demonstrator, Laura Zaraza. Although this is a monthly group that regularly meets you may still join us for a little stamping fun of your own. You'll be able to participate in some of our projects with us and see what the Stamper's 6 Club is all about. If you can't make it but would

like to purchase something prior to this night let us know.
